42nd MCBC Antique & Classic Boat Show August 11th, 2018 Westport, Ontario

The 42nd MCBC Antique and Classic Boat Show will be held on Saturday, August 11th in the Village of Westport, located at the west end of Upper Rideau Lake.

The Village of Westport is approximately 55 km northeast of Kingston and 115 km southwest of Ottawa, by land. Its natural beauty, historic downtown, and many unique shops and restaurants, make the Village a popular year round destination.

Upper Rideau Lake is part the Rideau Canal system, a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Canal System begins at Kingston, Ontario, just across the St. Lawrence River from Clayton, NY. The Canal provides a delightful three or four day leisurely cruise through beautiful pastoral countryside, magnificent lakes and quaint towns and villages to Ottawa.

The Boat Show will run from 10am - 5pm at the Village Harbour. This is a non-judged show open to MCBC and non-members. Awards will be presented for the Peoples' Choice, Captains' Choice, Hagerty Insurance Youth Judging awards (3) and special awards.

Please note that the paved parking area behind the Westport Spring Gazebo has been removed and converted into a park with grass and flower beds. While this gives us more room for vendor's tents and small boats which may be carried in, this area is off limits to vehicles and trailers.

The registration fee is \$20 per boat or land display. Please submit the accompanying Boat Show registration form by July 31, 2018. Registration is on a first come basis.

In lieu of a public admission charge the Village of Westport will be accepting voluntary donations to the Harbour Fund. Moneys raised will be used to enlarge and improve the Westport Harbour.

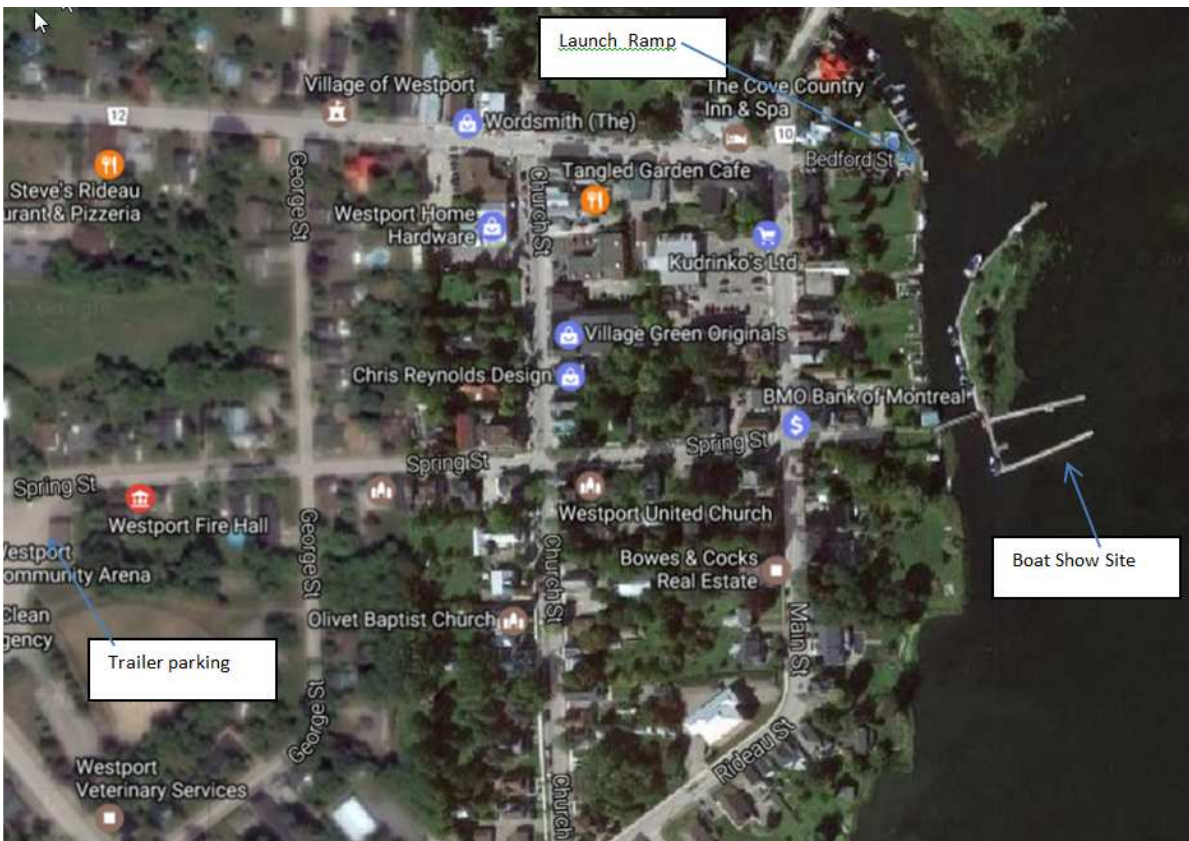
Logistical information (see enclosed map for location sites)

Trailer Parking: Space will be available for vehicles and trailers to park at the Westport Community Arena, 37 Spring St. (see map below).

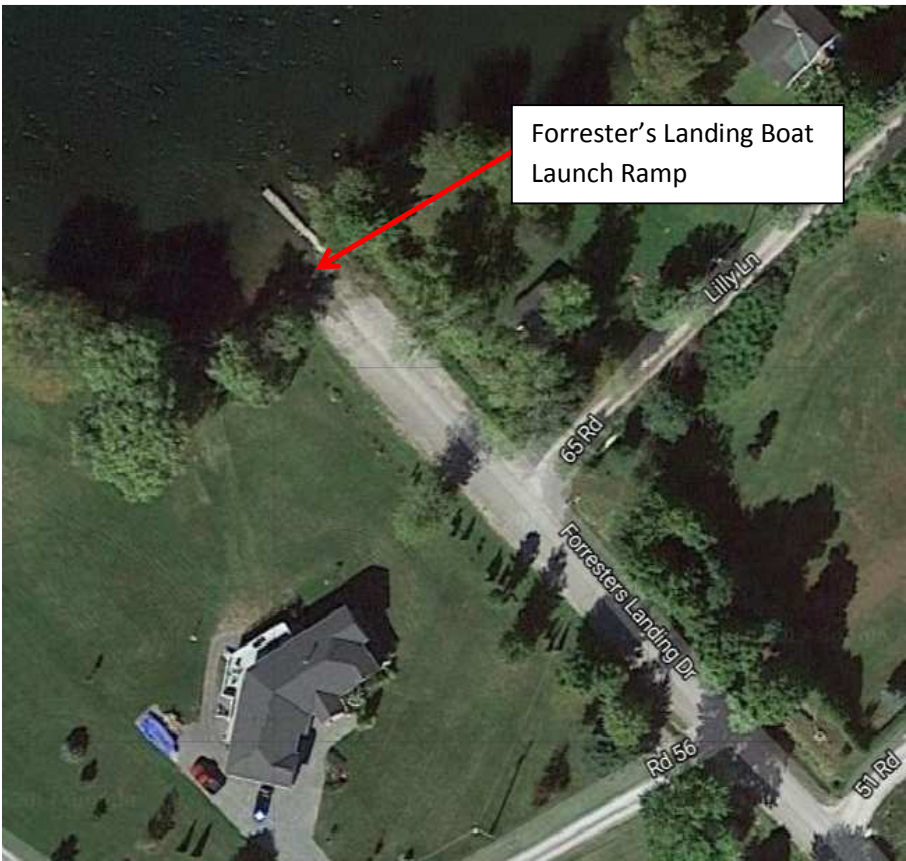
Overnight Docking: If you wish a dock space on Friday or Saturday night, please call or email the Westport dock master (Kevin Kardash) (613 273 8621 or harbourmaster@villageofwestport.ca) to reserve a space. Note that regular docking fees will apply on Friday night and after 5pm on Saturday. Information on docking fees can be found at <http://villageofwestport.ca/discover-westport/westport-municipal-harbour>
Security will be provided on Friday night.

Registration Area: Boat show registration desk will be located in the Westport Spring Pavilion at the foot of Fetch Murphy Way. Boat show registration packages and boat cards are available for pick-up there on Saturday morning.

Boat Launch (small boats): For smaller boats, a village boat launch is located at the Public Docks at the foot of Bedford Street (see map below). This ramp is very steep and may not be suitable for larger boats. For larger boats see below.



Boat Launch (larger boats): For larger boats, a better launch ramp is available at the end of Forrester's Landing Drive (see maps below). There is some roadside trailer parking at the ramp. Additional trailer parking is available at the town arena.

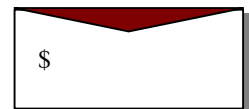
